**Statement from the U.S. Council of Muslim Organizations  
Sharia-Free America: Why Political Islam & Sharia Law are Incompatible with the U.S.  
Constitution: Part II”  
House Judiciary Subcommittee on the Constitution and Limited Government**

The Honorable Members of the House Judiciary Subcommittee on Constitution and Limited Government,

With today’s hearing, the committee has elected to endanger the lives of our 4.5 million American Muslim neighbors by promoting lies and hate during a time of record-setting harassment and discrimination against this community.

As representatives of the more than 55 Muslim organizations serving this community across the United States, we denounce this shameful use of our government’s resources. We will continue to advocate tirelessly on behalf of the Muslim community’s right to belong and to thrive.

We call on this Committee, and on all leaders at the state and national level, to repudiate the unconstitutional weaponization of government against American Muslims—to reject the politics of fear and reaffirm that constitutional rights are universal, non-negotiable, and equally protected.
